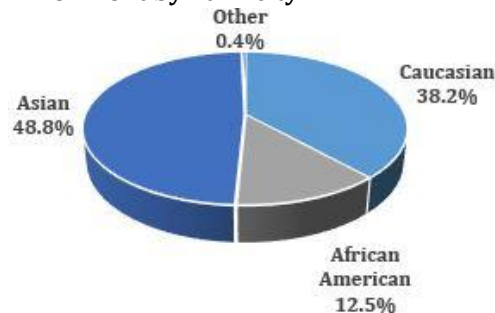

## CLASS SCHEDULE AND CURRICULUM
