<u>Goal</u>: Students, or teams of students, will create an app. This app should promote, and increase visibility, thus increasing customer visits for Johns Creek businesses (specifically focusing on small businesses). The app must be functional and visibly appealing for all ages.

*Prize money will be divided between the school or teacher and the team member(s): school or teacher receives half and the team receives half to divide among its' members # Participants that win first and second place will be asked to join the selection

committee for next year's competition focus.

Important Notes:

- (1) Any costs occurred during development will be covered by the participants.
- (2) First place app will be compiled & released to the app stores by JCA or JC CVB.
- (3) Hybrid app is encouraged, but not mandatory.
- (4) Teams may be utilized: they cannot exceed four people & the majority of each team must consist of Johns Creek residents
- (5) Participants are encouraged to visit local small businesses to better understand what might be beneficial and to get input from the local small business community.
- (6) Small businesses include restaurants, boutiques, gift shops, and any other business with less than 15 full time employees.
- (7) Students / Teams are highly encouraged to use the hypothetical scenarios provided to better understand the minimum features that should be included in the app design. Additional features are certainly encouraged.
- (8) Esri has prepared a video for participants which show how to utilize their mapping software and the various other analytical tools they are allowing the students to use free of charge. - (9) Students may use outside sources for assistance. These outside sources must be referenced.

REQUIREMENTS:

- (1) Focus is solely on Johns Creek small businesses
- (2) ArcGIS API for JavaScript for connecting to maps & data services
- (3) Web based services from City of Johns Creek GIS Department (for business base map)
- (4) Cannot be a commercial product or service this is not a platform for advertising a commercial product or service
- (5) Third party commercial services cannot be used to build the app; however, a third party toolkit is acceptable as long as it is referenced as a resource.
- (6) Each participant must complete the Student Waiver and Participant Form, which must be submitted by *August 12, 2016*. Forms can be emailed to: blavigno@johnscreekadvantage.org.

December 1, 2015 - September 4, 2016:

- Concepts may be submitted to JCA once during this period for guidance/helpful hints:
 - Concepts submittals should be no more than a 2 page concept description of app functionality, which must be accompanied by one possible planned mockup of the app.
