Credit is awarded every 18 weeks (.5 units per course) with a maximum of six (6) units earned during the regular school year.

Administration

23 credits are required for graduation.

**English**– 4 units of English Language Arts required for all students.

**Math**– 4 units of math required for all students

**Science**– 4 units of science required for all students, to include 1 unit of biology and 1 unit of physical science or physics.

**Social Studies**– 3 units of social studies required for all students to include 1 unit of World History, 1 unit of U.S. History, 1/2 unit of American Government and 1/2 unit of Economics.

**Health & PE**– 1/2 unit of Health and 1/2 unit of Personal Fitness are required for all students.

**Career/Technical Education and/or World Language and/or Fine Arts**  
3 units are required from Career Technical Education, World Language and/or Fine Arts.

Students planning to attend a University System of Georgia institution must earn 2 units in the same World Language.

**Electives**– 4 additional elective units.

In order to earn a diploma all students are required to complete a minimum of 23 credits .
